1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs. S. M. T. Ford and O. Williams.

2. MEMBERS' DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

No declarations of interest were made.

3. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

There was no public participation in the proceedings.

4. CHAIRMAN'S ADDRESS

The Chairman, Cllr. J. S. Phillips welcomed members and guests to the meeting and reflected on the past year. Cllr. Phillips was very proud of being the Council's Chairman and it had been an honour and privilege to have performed the role.

Cllr. Phillips spoke about the many events she had participated in during the year with her attending over 104 engagements, and that it had been a very busy but enjoyable and memorable year.

However, two events were deserving of special mention; firstly Ysgol Heol Goffa's prize giving day, where she was overwhelmed by the love and happiness that emanated from the pupils and staff. It was a humbling experience, more so in light of being able to share in a special moment when it was announced that a former pupil of Pwll Primary School had been nominated as head boy.

The second event took place at Prince Philip Hospital. The council had previously made a major contribution towards the creation of a new reflection garden and which was unveiled on 26 July, 2024. The sculpture in the centre of the garden was by Leigh Odishow and was called 'Touch of Hope'. It captured a touching moment during the pandemic when a grandfather who was a patient at the hospital and his grandson were witnessed trying to communicate through the hospital window by pointing their fingers to reach out to one another as they were prevented from physical contact during this unprecedented time. This was particularly poignant in light of the grandfather passing away soon after.

Cllr. Phillips then referred to the charity fundraising event she had organised in support of The Phil Bennett Foundation and Ty Bryngwyn Hospice in Llanelli. The event had raised £3,000 in total with the proceeds being shared equally between the two charities.

She also referred to the excellent work performed by the council over the last 12 months and what the council had achieved during her term of office. She was particularly proud of the various organisations that the council worked with and thanked them for their support. She also extended thanks to the Chairman and Consort, Carmarthenshire County Council, Llanelli Town Mayor and Mayoress and to all other civic dignitaries who she had worked with during the civic year.

In closing Cllr. Phillips paid tribute to the valued support provided to her throughout the year by the Council's staff and then wished the Chairman Elect, Cllr. Martin V. Davies and his Consort Ms Ruth Thomas every success for the year ahead and it was
