Subject: PURCHASE OF J.D. INNESS' PAINTING OF KIDWELLY CASTLE

#### Good afternoon

The Friends of Parc Howard Llanelli Museum have another (third) opportunity to purchase a painting by our own internationally recognised Llanelli born artist James Dickson Innes. After the disappointment of losing out with the last two Innes' paintings that went to auction last year our local Innes scout has discovered another painting which is a watercolour landscape of Kidwelly Castle for sale by private treaty in a provincial Welsh art gallery. Images of the unframed and framed painting are attached for your reference.

The painting is one of only three local views painted by Innes before he was ensnared by the Arenig Mountains in North Wales and the Collioure Mountains in the South of France. The other two local paintings are "Furnace Quarry" (Llanelli), on display in Parc Howard Museum and the other "A View Of A Town" (Llanelli) in a private collection. Whilst it may be thought that Innes was a Llanelli town born painter, he lived in the former Llanelli Borough Area (although he actually died two years before it actually received borough status in 1916) and painted the three local landscapes mentioned above from within the same area and this area is represented by artefacts displayed at Parc Howard Museum.

Naturally, we need to secure the painting before the gallery sells it to another buyer, although it has been removed from display pending sale to us and donation to Parc Howard Museum. The museum conservator has inspected the painting and has reported that it is in a good condition although it has been reframed at some time. The gallery is holding out for the asking price of £6,000 despite the reframing, which is still cheaper than the auction prices achieved for the other two paintings. A provenance statement from the gallery states that it has been in the collection of a Brecon area resident for some time, but does not trace ownership back to the early 1900s.

The Friends are, therefore, writing to ask if you can please support the current purchase, which if successful, will be donated to Parc Howard Museum.

I hope that you are able to support us on this occasion and, if so, can you please confirm your offer as soon as possible so that the painting can be purchased.
