**237. CARMARTHENSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(DOG CONTROL) PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER 2016**

Members considered a consultation document received from the Local Environmental Quality Policy Officer, Carmarthenshire County Council requesting the council to support the proposal to extend the duration of the order for the next three years.

The Carmarthenshire County Council (Dog Control) Public Spaces Protection Order 2016 came into force on 1 July, 2016. It was initially made for a period of 3 years. In 2022 the Order was extended for a further period of 3 years with effect from 1 July, 2022. It was therefore due to expire in 2025. Carmarthenshire County Council wished to extend the duration of the order for the next three years in accordance with Section 60 of the Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014.

Following discussion, it was

RESOLVED that:

1. The clerk be authorised to complete the accompanying questionnaire in support of the proposal to extend the Order for three years.
2. Members shall also be authorised to respond on an individual basis to the questionnaire in respect of issues relating to their own electoral wards, if warranted.
