369. CONSULTATION BEFORE APPLYING FOR PLANNING PERMISSION NOTICE UNDER ARTICLES 2C AND 2D OF THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT PROCEDURE) (WALES) ORDER 2012 – DAFEN EMPLOYMENT SITE, HEOL RHOSYN, DAFEN

Cllr. S. R. Bowen declared a personal interest in the following item as he operated a business establishment in Heol Rhosyn, Dafen.

Correspondence was received from WSP Planning Consultants before applying for planning permission on behalf of Welsh Ministers for the construction of new access roads, associated infrastructure and engineering works to form plots plus outline planning permission for new industrial units on the plots on land at Dafen Employment Site, Heol Rhosyn, Llanelli.

Members considered the bundle of correspondence forming part of the pre-application consultation documents paying particular focus to the accompanying Planning, Design and Access Statement.

Following discussion it was

RESOLVED that the Clerk be authorised to respond to WSP Planning Consultants acknowledging the principal of development associated with the general proposal but notwithstanding this that members' views are taken into consideration prior to the submission of the formal planning application in regard to: the impact on local biodiversity; site surface water generation and attenuation to prevent flooding elsewhere in lower lying areas of the catchment area; and also the level of noise generated from the site once operational and which might potentially affect the general enjoyment of residential properties along Llethri Road, Felinfoel and Cilsaig, Dafen. Moreover that enquiries be made with the planning consultants as to whether there is scope to extend the proposed site roadway further west to service the Prima Foods Business, to significantly improve site access to this business establishment thereby alleviating logistics traffic from using the current unsuitable road entrance accessed via Globe Row, Dafen, in the interests of improving residential amenity and general highway safety in Dafen.

370. THE COUNTY OF CARMARTHENSHIRE IMPOSITION OF 40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT ORDER 25 UNDER SECTIONS 84(1)(A), 84(2) AND 124 OF PARAGRAPH 27 OF SCHEDULE 9 TO THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ACT 1984 (AS AMENDED) – IMPOSITION OF 40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT – HTTR/1844
